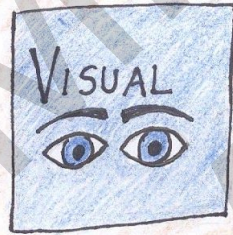


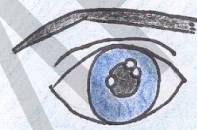

Visual, Auditory, and Kinesthetic."



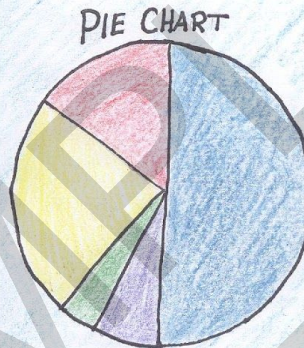
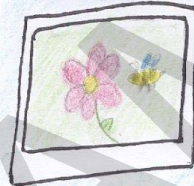

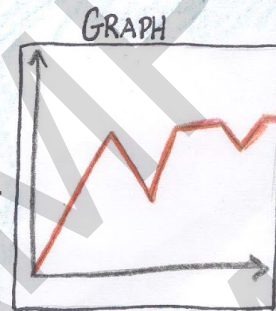
Visual learning means you learn better by seeing pictures, watching videos, or by seeing diagrams.



I get the picture!

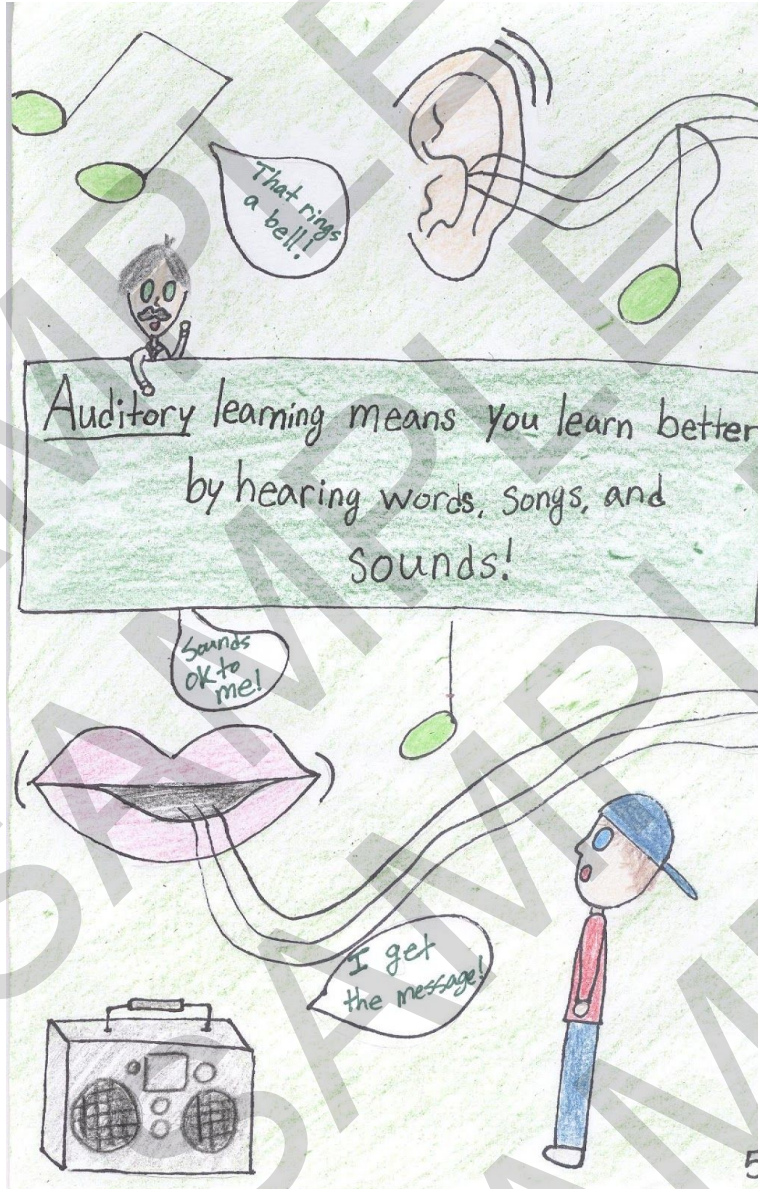


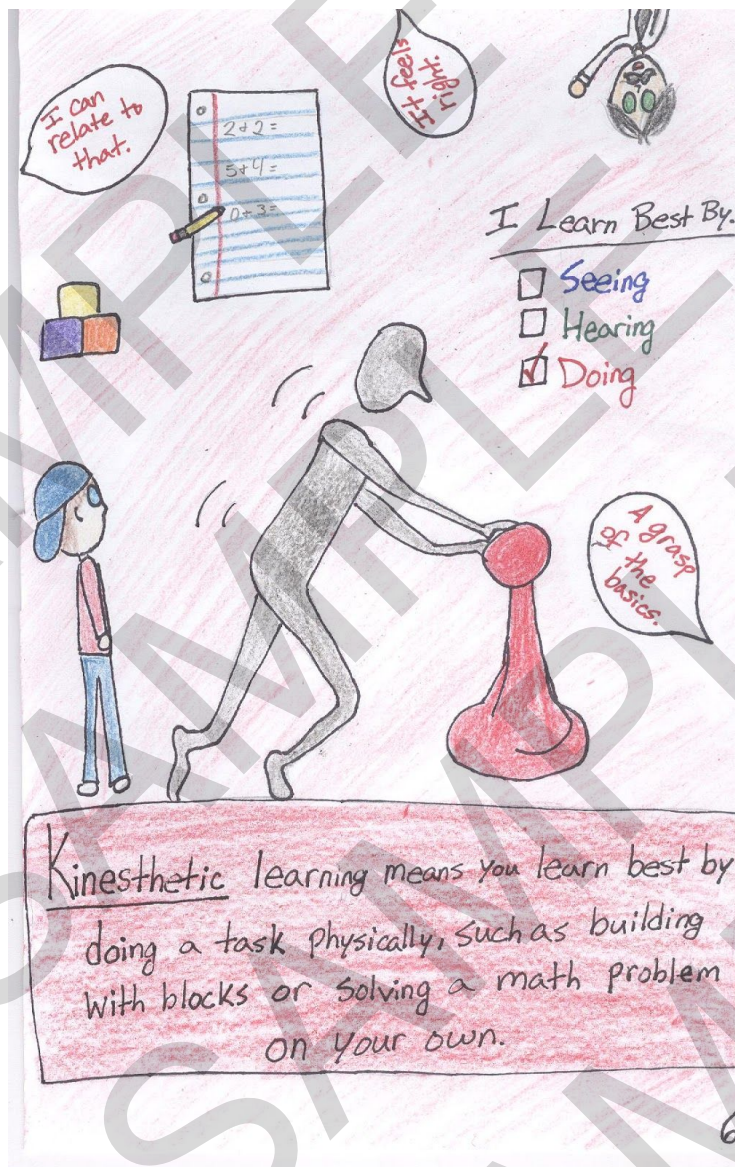

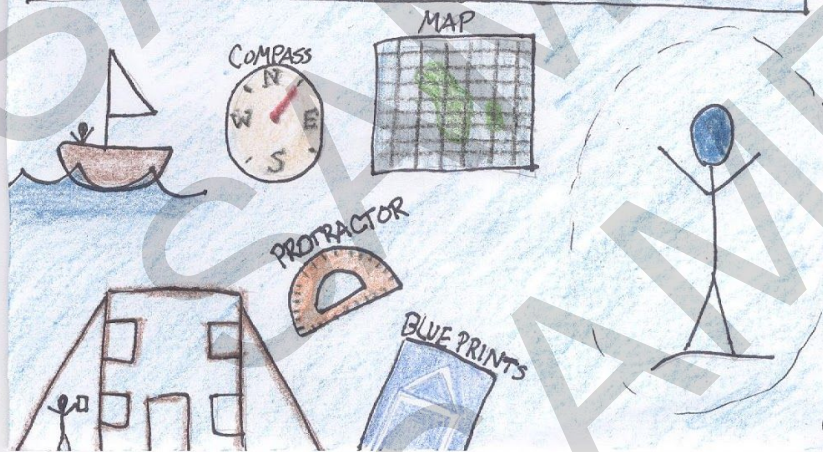
"He created his own list of what he called 'Multiple Intelligences.' This just means that people learn and understand in many different ways."

Jimmy and Professor Think discover how Visual/Spatial thinkers learn through Door #1.

Visual/Spatial intelligence means you are very good at creating and manipulating mental images.

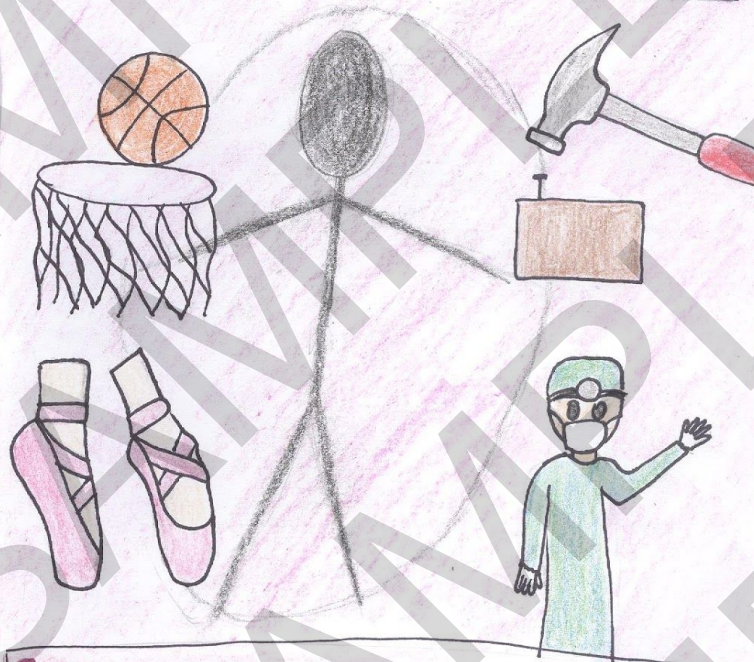


These types of learners think like architects and sailors since they think in terms of physical space and are aware of their environments.



Door #2 taught Jimmy and Professor Think about Bodily-Kinesthetic learners.

Bodily-Kinesthetic intelligence means you learn through physical activity and expressing yourself.

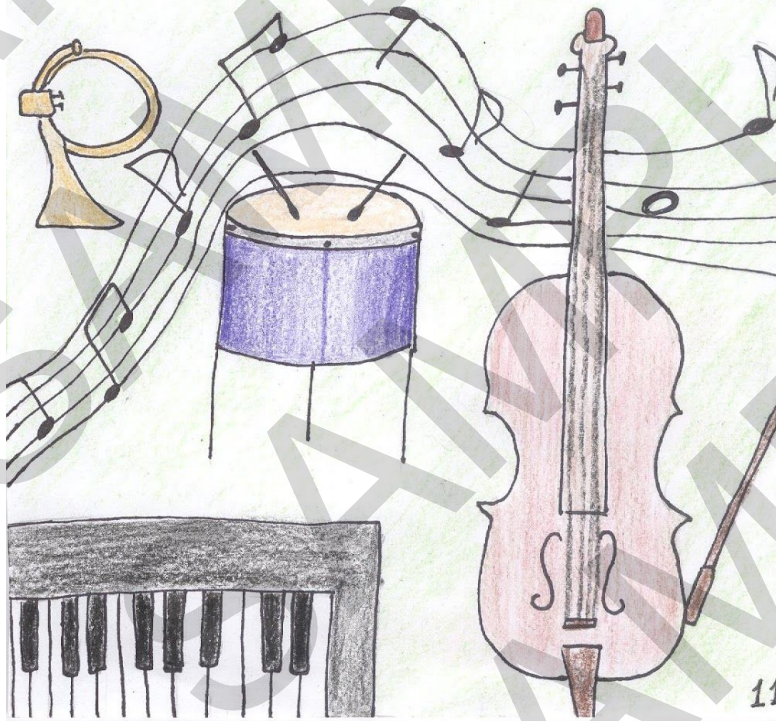


Bodily-Kinesthetic thinkers use the body to learn, just like dancers, surgeons, athletes, and craftspeople!

Musical intelligence means you learn best with music and rhythmic movements.

These musical learners are sensitive to sounds in their environments, and they may study better with music in the background.

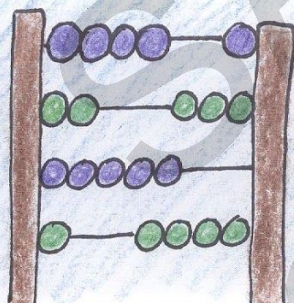
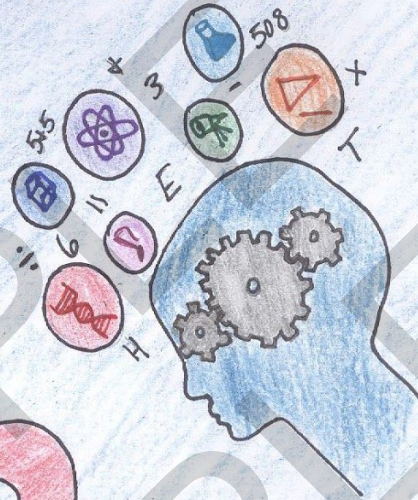


Jimmy and Professor Think find out about Logical/
